

Adolescent Treatment Resources in Alabama

- Adolescent substance abuse treatment providers provide services for individuals ages 13-17.
- There are certified providers and contracted (state funded) providers who provide Early Intervention, Outpatient, Intensive Outpatient, and Residential Treatment.
- If an adolescent is need of treatment, upon initial contact with a provider a screening is done to determine eligibility for substance abuse services. If screening warrants an assessment, the assessment will determine the level of care required.
- **THE SCREENING AND THE ASSESSMENT BEGINS THE PROCESS.**
- If the family is willing to pay out of pocket or has a billable insurance that covers substance use treatment, Bradford Health Services and other private clinics may be an option for treatment.
- It is important to know about the treatment resources in your particular community and it is equally important to know how to access them. 12 Step Support Groups are available at no cost in most communities. Individuals may attend without a referral or an appointment.
