

# 2020-2021 Alabama Department of Early Childhood Education, Office of School Readiness: First Class Pre-K Remote Instruction Guidance: First Nine Weeks and Beyond

**Introduction:** This guidance is provided as an addendum to The Alabama Department of Early Childhood Education (ADECE), First Class Pre-K Reopening and Operating Framework, <http://children.alabama.gov/reopening-guidance/>. This Remote Instruction Guidance is designed to support teachers as they provide high quality distance-learning education to First Class Pre-K students. The Addendum consists of three components: (1) digital access to “dynamic planning tools that help to individualize instruction, facilitate communication between the (teacher) and families, streamline weekly planning processes, and offer access to new family-facing resources to build consistency in learning experiences” Teaching Strategies™, (2) virtual classroom social connection guidance, and (3) professional development to support teachers with the implementation process.

### Options for using the Teaching Strategies™ The Creative Curriculum® Cloud:

### Additional Considerations

- Each program is responsible for selecting the LMS that best meets their needs, which could include Schoology, Google Classroom, Canvas, etc.
- All LMS platforms listed above are both app and web-based programs.
- The Creative Curriculum® Cloud will be available to all First Class Pre-K classrooms; however the ADECE *does not require classrooms to use this curriculum.*
- Schools PLP will be available to First Class Pre-K classrooms whose LEA opts to use Schoology; however, the ADECE *does not require classrooms to use this curriculum.*
