

Eight Regions






- Public School: 945 classes


- Private School: 7 classes

- Faith-Based Childcare: 32 classes




Number of Children Being Served by First Class Pre-K




Though half or more of children arrived in First Class Pre-K below developmental expectations, nearly all were meeting or exceeding by the end of the year.





80-90% of children who arrived in First Class Pre-K below developmental expectations, were meeting or exceeding by the end of the year.


Spring Performance of Children who were Below Developmental Expectations at First Class Pre-K Entry Teaching Strategies GOLD



By the end of the year, the majority of children in First Class Pre-K tested "ready" for Kindergarten in each domain.


70% of children were kindergarten ready in at least 5 of 6 domains.

High Quality First Class Pre-K Teachers

- ✓ CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System)
 - research-based instrument for assessing quality of teacher-child interactions
 - **proven valid and reliable** in studies conducted by researchers at the *University of Virginia* and the *Gates Foundation's Measures of Effective Teaching Study*
- ✓ Alabama's First Class Pre-K Teachers' *CLASS* averages are above the national average in every category
